



SKILLS THE NEW GLOBAL CURRENCY

- Ol World Economic Forum and ILO:
- By 2030, 170 million new jobs to be created
 92 million will be displaced
 1.1 billion jobs will be radically transformed
 by technology.
- Employers: 62% citing skills shortages as a major barrier to transformation.
 Only 38% of employers expect talent availability to improve.

EXPLOSION IN AI COURSES AND AI LITERACY

Coursera's Job Skills Report 2025:

2023-24: 866% growth in GenAl courses! 400 new courses!

- 1,100% increase in demand from those already employed.
- but just 500% growth from existing students.

GenAl Gender Gap report. Enrolments in Generative Al courses on Coursera in the UK rose by 227% over the past year, only 31% of those learners were women

BRIDGING THE DIGITAL SKILLS GAP

- Ol NCFE's No one Left Offline
- 1 in 5 people don't have the digital skills for every day tasks
- Oyer 50% of respondents aged 18 and under lacked the essential skills required for modern life, despite often being assumed to be 'digital natives.'



DISCONNECTED: AI DEMAND AND DIGITAL SKILLS PIPELINE

- Ol Digital Poverty Alliance:
- 7.5 million people, 18% of UK adults, lack the basic Digital Skills required for work.
- Only 17% of Teachers have received formal training in Digital Skills
- By age 14, 94% of Girls and 79% of Boys no longer study Computing!
 In 2013, 69% of Girls and 72% of Boys took a GCSE
 Computing exam!
